

2. Payment by **Curtin ePay**

Choose from various payment modes such as S PAY GLOBAL (previously known as SarawakPay), FPX (Malaysian Bank Account), Flywire (International), Credit Card (VISA/MasterCard) and Charge Card (Amex).

Online Credit Card payment: Using a Visa or MasterCard on the visa.educationmalaysia.gov.my website. Please note that if you select this payment method, there will be a 3% Convenience Fee added to the total amount requested for your application

IMPORTANT NOTES

1. Do not navigate away from the webpage until the payment is completed. Once the payment has been approved by your bank, you will be re-directed back to the Application Form to complete the application. Your application will be submitted to EMGS for processing and you will receive a notification of your application number for your reference. An email with the application details and payment confirmation will also be sent to the email address that you used to register your EMGS account.
2. Please verify your application details in the **“Application Review”** tab. Read the Terms and Conditions and click **“Submit Application”** after selecting the checkbox to confirm that you consent to the processing of your personal data and the terms and conditions by EMGS. Please note that you will not be able to proceed without providing your consent. The proof of application and payment need to be provided to International Student Office for University record.
3. EMGS will notify International Student Office that you have successfully submitted your application and will require further verification and approval from us before it can be processed by EMGS and Immigration Department. Kindly allow at **least three (3) working days** for the verification and approval process.
4. You may check the progress of your application by login into EMGS Portal. Once your Electronic Visa Approval Letter (eVAL) has been issued by the Immigration Department, the next step is to plan your travel to Malaysia.
 - For students from Single-Entry Visa required countries, please **DO NOT** purchase your flight ticket before your Single-Entry Visa (Please contact/visit the nearest Malaysian Embassy/Consulate/High Commission in your country) OR [eVISA](#) is issued because entering Malaysia without a valid SEV or eVISA, you will be issued a Not To Land (NTL) order by the Immigration at the Malaysian Airport whereby you will be deported back to your home country.
 - For students from non-SEV required countries, you may proceed to purchase your flight ticket once you have received your Electronic Visa Approval Letter (eVAL) and you will have to apply for a Visa on Arrival (VOA) once you arrive at the Malaysian International Airport.
 - For more accurate and up-to-date information on the visa requirements, you are advised to contact the Malaysian High Commission/Embassy/Consulate in your country.
