For two whole days, the Curtin Malaysia Careers Fair 2024 will give you the opportunity to introduce your organisation, internship and graduate programmes; share career opportunities and carry out recruitment activities with students and graduates, including those from other institutions, as well as working adults seeking new career prospects.
