- Applicants must not be presently holding other scholarships
- Amount of award and duration: 25%, 50% or 100% scholarship towards course fee for first year of study.
- How to Apply: Application form is downloadable at scholarships.curtin.edu.my. Completed form must be submitted to Loans & Scholarships Unit, Student Services Department, Student Central before closing date.
- Offer/Closing Date: Twice a year during semester. Refer to website for actual closing date.

 - (a) Full time enrolled student in Degree Engineering and Science programmes at Curtin Malaysia
