- Not presently holding other scholarships.

#### Amount of award and duration

The scholarship covers 50% of the tuition fee for the entire duration of the program (3 - 4)years depending on the program of study). \*All other fees and expenses are to be borne by the recipients.

- The CWA of 80% must be achieved at the time of application.
- Please also note that students meeting the criteria are eligible to apply for the scholarship. The scholarship is not guaranteed as all applications go through a selection process. Only selected students will receive the scholarship.
