### Pro Vice-Chancellor Excellence Scholarship

#### Eligibility Criteria

- International and Malaysian citizen
- Full-time student enrolled at Curtin Malaysia
- For Malaysian, the course you enroll in must not be covered under the Free Tertiary Education Scheme (FTES)
- Current Curtin Malaysia degree students (second year onwards) with the latest CWA 80%
- Not presently holding other scholarships.

#### Amount of award and duration

The scholarship covers 50% of the tuition fee for the entire duration of the program (3 – 4) years depending on the program of study).

*\*All other fees and expenses are to be borne by the recipients.*

#### Note:

- The CWA of 80% must be achieved at the time of application.
- Please also note that students meeting the criteria are eligible to apply for the scholarship. The scholarship is not guaranteed as all applications go through a selection process. Only selected students will receive the scholarship.

#### Application process:

The application must be submitted with all the required documents as below:

- Complete the online application form. Please login using your Curtin Malaysia student webmail or gmail.
- Copy of your passport or IC number
- Copy of academic e-record.

#### Scholarship availability

- Offered in Semester 1 only
- The online application period is to be announced.

#### General term

- The University reserves the right to vary any decisions and the terms and conditions of the scholarships at its discretion. The decisions made by the University will be final and binding.

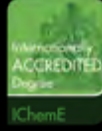
